March 2023 marks the one-year anniversary of the HOA's purchase of The Bay Club. Over the last 12 months your Board of Directors has worked to establish sound business practices to ensure the long-term viability of this gem on the bay, as well as to present improved food quality, timely speed of delivery and heightened service levels for member enjoyment.

Our decision to self-manage The Club and hire our own management team has yielded huge dividends as we continue to focus our efforts on enhancing the facility, customizing events, and establishing programs to meet the requests of our membership.

The recently established Social and Amenities Advisory Committees are integral to this effort and are working with the management team to incorporate your feedback into our plans. These committee members and The Club's GM, Jim Musick, welcome your input and are working very hard to make positive change. We will also be sending a survey to membership to get more-specific feedback, so please keep an eye out for this communication in the next few weeks.

As part of our efforts to improve the environment, we implemented policies to ensure member-access to The Club.
